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EMPLOYME IS GOING LIVE

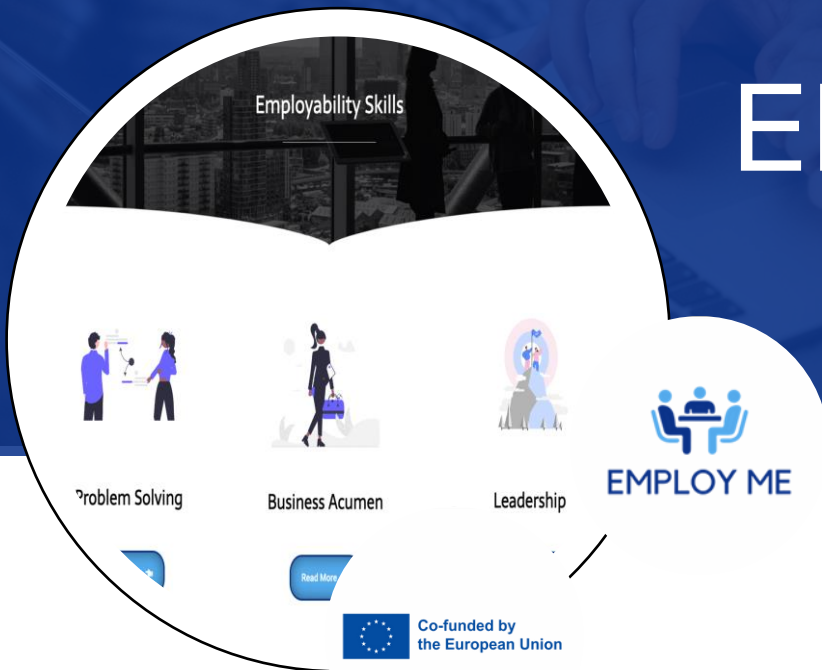
The project has progressed a lot since our last update. We are proud to announce that the Employability Toolkit is done and uploaded on our website: employ-me.eu!

The Employability Skills Toolkit is a collection of bite-sized lessons of 10 employability skills carefully chosen by our team. The 10 skills we chose are:

- Teamwork
- Business Acumen
- Persuasion and Negotiation
- Communication
- Organisation
- Leadership
- Confidence
- Problem Solving
- Perseverance and Motivation
- Time Management

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Under each skill, you can find theoretical knowledge on the subject, as well as gain practical skills through exercises and games. Each skill has at least 3 short lessons that dive into the subject, and at the end of each topic you can find an assessment quiz to test your knowledge retention.

Currently the Toolkit is only available in English, but our team is finalizing the translated versions of the gamified materials – you can expect versions in Lithuanian, French, Bulgarian, Greek, and Spanish.

BUT HOW DO I USE IT?

If you are wondering how to properly use the Toolkit, our team has created a Handbook for users. In the Handbook you can find out about international research on the unemployment of migrants in partner countries; the methodology that was used in creation of the whole Toolkit; a summary of each skill we decided to focus on; and a practical guide on who can use it and how.

The Handbook is going to be finalized by the end of October 2023, so you will be able to find it on the website already in November!

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WHAT'S NEXT?

After uploading the translated versions of our Employability Toolkit, the partnership is planning piloting sessions to test it out.
